Healthcare from your home

In an effort to minimize exposure during the state of emergency with COVID-19, Peninsula Regional Medical Center will be conducting appointments via telehealth utilizing real-time audio and video communication. You can now have a consultation with your care team from the comfort of your own home.

Using WebEx is safe, secure, and protects your privacy.

What you will need

- 1. A working laptop, tablet or smart phone- with a front camera.
- 2. A fully charged device, or access to power.
- 3. An internet connection (WI-FI or Cellular).
- 4. Your email address.
- 5. A well-lit space so your care team can see you.
- 6. A quiet space to reduce distractions.
- 7. Headphones if you have them available, so that you can connect to your device for clear audio and to protect your privacy.

Getting Started

- 1. **Get ready** Prepare for your virtual consult with a quiet space, the right lighting, quality WIFI and video. You'll receive an invitation from your healthcare provider, with instructions on how to join.
- 2. **Join your virtual appointment** Click the Join link in the invitation for your Telehealth appointment, which can be found in your email inbox. Just like an in-person appointment, join 5 minutes early to prepare.
- 3. **Receive virtual care** Video is critical for a personal interaction, so make sure the care team can see and hear you clearly.
